Kustavi, Taivassalo, Vehmaa

A new experience for the archipelago in 2025 is the Kihti Tour, which takes the tourist on a tour of the Kustavi, Brändö and Pargas archipelago. We recommend this route especially for those who want to explore the archipelago by bike or on foot! The journey of approx. 120 km (60 km road) includes four longer ferry sections. Requires an overnight stay or careful planning due to connection schedules.

A taste of history can be sought in the medieval stone churches and churchyards. It is also worth remembering the unique local museums of the archipelago, such as the Archipelago Museum in Kustavi, the Viiaste Manor Museum in Taivassalo and the Museum of Local History and Stone Carving in Vehmaa. For an interesting nature trail experience, visit the Tummamäki nature trail with its troll and moss trails in an old quarry in Vehmaa. For a seaside experience, try the Laavupolku trail at Hakkenpää in Taivassalo.

Brändö

Brändö offers a piece of Åland just two hours from Turku. Brändö consists of over a thousand islands and offers plenty to experience for those who enjoy scenic archipelago landskapes. Simply traveling along the winding road through the islands is an experience in itself, unveiling unforgettable views of the sea and the traditional Archipelago landscapes. Stop off at Åva village harbour, Torsholma observation tower, nature trails, Lappos Archipelago Museum or the frisbee golf course. Or just take a break and soak up the island's unhurried atmosphere. The new Archipelago Trail, the Kihti Trail, also travels through Brändö, offering the chance to spend the best days of your holiday enjoying the varied archipelago nature.
